The Need

We serve working families, the disabled and retired seniors in our community who may struggle with hunger, job loss, illness, accidents, death of a loved one or reduction in their living standard because of a changing economy.

What Can I Do?

You can help by donating nutritious, non-perishable food to the WIN Food Pantry such as canned goods (beef, fish, chicken, vegetables, fruit, hearty soups), dried milk, pasta sauce, peanut butter, jelly, etc; regular size kitchen and bathroom cleansers; paper products such as toilet paper and paper towels; and personal care products such as toothpaste, shampoo, soap, etc. Our current needs are posted on our website. You can also donate your time, money and talents as well as encourage your religious or service organization to work with us to become better informed about the needs in our community.

PROVIDING COMMUNITY SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF WAYNE

The primary purpose of the WIN Food Pantry is to distribute food, cleaning supplies and personal care products to residents of Wayne who are in need. The Wayne Township Director of Senior and Social Services screens and documents all applicants and recommends appropriate assistance. All individuals and families receiving assistance pass through this process and are reevaluated on a continuing basis.

The operations of the pantry are modeled after a pantry which opened in 1984 as part of the relief efforts following devastating floods that year.

Aside from its very active food pantry, WIN's annual community service programs include providing Summer Sneakers & Tees, School Supplies and Back-to-School Clothing Store Vouchers to eligible families with school-age children. Also, Thanksgiving Baskets are distributed in November which include a frozen turkey and all the fixings to prepare a Thanksgiving meal.

PROMOTING UNDERSTANDING THROUGH EDUCATION AND COOPERATION

The Wayne Interfaith Network is comprised of representatives from Wayne houses of worship, individuals, and service organizations which share an informed concern for our community and surrounding areas.

Working together has fostered a bond of friendship and understanding among WIN members. We hope this goodwill continues to spread, promoting interfaith respect and understanding.

WHAT IS WIN?

The Wayne Interfaith Network (WIN) is a non-profit, 501(c)3 tax exempt coalition which aids Wayne residents. Representing a variety of faiths, WIN is an important contributor to the welfare of our community.
